Bar Association of the Kingdom of Cambodia (BAKC) was established in 1995. The legal profession in Cambodia was abolished by the Khmer Rouge regime in 1975 and it was not until 1995 that the National Assembly re-established the legal profession by enacting the Law on the Status of Lawyers to create the Bar Association of Kingdom of Cambodia. BAKC is a membership organization. All people who wish to practice law must be members of BAKC.
